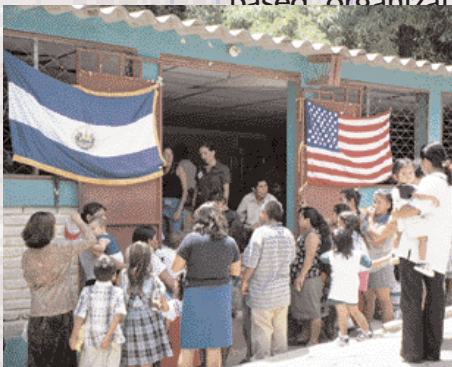
## PAST:

Organized in 1996 by a group of pediatricians in the wake of damages caused by Hurricane Mitch, annual missions to El Salvador provided medical care and cooperative training to affected areas. Realizing the need to be actively involved in the rebuilding of vital health care networks, **PFCAC** became a reality.



## PRESENT:

By joining hands with Salvadorian community based organizations and the National Children's Hospital, **PFCAC** is providing a permanent presence for health-care in a medically underserved area by building and equipping a medical clinic. Providing ongoing support for this program will require your help.



## FUTURE:

Once the support mechanism is in place for ongoing medical care of children in El Salvador, similar programs will be established in other countries throughout Latin America.



To give selflessly of time, energy and money is the dedication found in the group that makes up Pediatricians for Central America's Children (PFCAC). **PFCAC** is an all-volunteer, not-for-profit, organization dedicated to improving the healthcare of children in Latin America. The group travels to Latin American countries bringing medical care and supplies to families in need.

**PFCAC** has developed a unique model which links the host government, local officials, local pediatric healthcare providers and local non-governmental community-based organizations working in cooperation with **PFCAC** to deliver medical care to the families of Latin America. The Foundation is supporting a nutritional program and a day-care center as well.

The group in the United States is based on Long Island, New York. It is made up of volunteers from all walks of life: pediatricians, nurses, technologists, health care administrators and any one willing to help. In addition to traveling to host countries, the group holds various events and reaches out to raise funds and/or equipment to further the mission. One hundred percent of the funds raised are used to support the programs in the host counties.
